

## ***Stay with the one you started with***

XALATAN is indicated for the reduction of elevated intraocular pressure (IOP) in patients with open-angle glaucoma (OAG) or ocular hypertension (OH). XALATAN can cause changes to pigmented tissues. Most frequently reported are increased pigmentation of the iris, periorbital tissue (eyelid) and eyelashes, and growth of eyelashes. Pigmentation is expected to increase as long as XALATAN is administered. Iris pigmentation is likely to be permanent while eyelid skin darkening and eyelash changes may be reversible.
